## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO UCSB

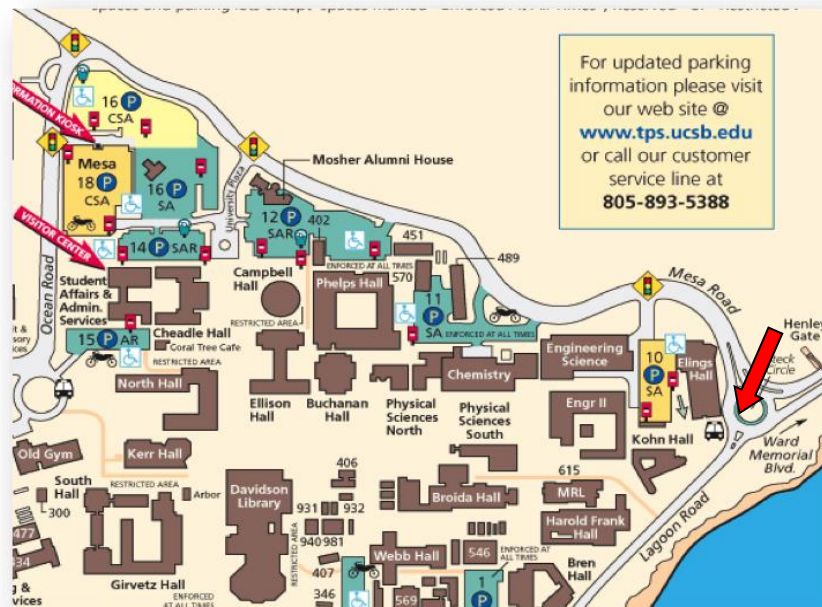
*From the south:*

1. Take highway 101 North.
2. Approximately 6 miles past downtown Santa Barbara, merge onto highway 217 W towards UCSB.
3.  At the end of highway 217, pass through the Henley Gate and turn right onto Mesa Road.
4.  Turn left at the first set of lights into parking structure #10.

*From the north:*

1. Take 101 South.
2. Approximately 7 miles before reaching downtown Santa Barbara, take exit 104 for Patterson Ave.
3.  Turn left onto Patterson Ave and cross the bridge over highway 101
4.  Turn left immediately after crossing the bridge and get into the left lane to get onto highway 217. (The entrance ramp splits; 217 is to the left and 101 North is to the right.)
5.  At the end of highway 217, pass through the Henley Gate and turn right onto Mesa Road.
6.  Turn left at the first set of lights into parking structure #10.

**PARKING** Park at top of Lot 10, if you do not have a parking meter. People with meters may park anywhere on the top 4 floors of the lot.



**PLEASE NOTE:** Eling's Hall is right next to (and east of) lot 10
